Joining the Carpenters Union in Alberta

- The Carpenters Union is interested in representing all tradespeople working at the trades we represent: carpenters, scaffolders, ISM/drywallers, & roofers.
- If you have an interest in becoming a member, fill out our council application form which is available at one of our offices in Edmonton, Fort McMurray or Calgary, or online @ albertacarpenters.com.
- The application form requires proof of your time at the trade and any trade certificates or documents which support your application.
- Entry level applicants - applicants without experience or certification – will be reviewed.
- Assisting the Organizing Department is always helpful in achieving membership.

What we need to see for proof

- The Union will not be your employer. - Contractors will be. Resumes are not helpful as proof of past experience. We seek to establish your credentials as a tradesperson for employment by our union contractors.
- Journeyman certificates and apprenticeship documents are proof of your level of achievement at the trade.
- The Union is also interested in you if you don't have certificates but have learned your trade on job sites, working on the tools (time in the trade).
- Pay stubs or Records of Employment are proof of past work experience and capabilities. They help determine your status either as a journeyman or your apprentice level. These documents will be scrutinized for authenticity. Letters and resumes can be helpful if they are accompanied by the above mentioned documents.

Initiation Fees and Dues

- Orientations are on specific days and you will be contacted as to where and when to attend once we have assessed and accepted your membership application. We will require your dues of \$25.00 per month to be paid forward for six months for a total of \$150.00, plus local initiation and social fees. There is a slight variance in fees between Edmonton/Fort McMurray and Calgary/Red Deer. We absolutely **will not accept money in advance**. This does not expedite the process. Your application will not be considered any sooner and any monies offered will be returned to you.
- You will become a full member when your application is processed, you have attended an orientation, your dues and fees are paid in full, and you have attended a local union meeting to swear in.
- It is recommended that you join the local closest to your place of permanent residence.
